During the 1965 India-Pak war, when the country faced food scarcity Lal Bahadur

Shastri, who was the Prime Minister then, stopped drawing his salary. Lal Bahadur

Shastri's slogan 'Jai Jawan, Jai Kisan' during the 1965 war boosted the morale of the

soldiers as well as farmers amid food scarcity. Lal Bahadur Shastri promoted the White

Revolution, a countrywide campaign to increase milk production. He supported the Amul

milk co-operative at Anand in Gujarat and created the National Dairy Development

Board. To boost India's food production, Lal Bahadur Shastri promoted the Green

Revolution in India in 1965. His tenure as the Prime Minister was only for 19 months. He

died in Tashkent on January 11, 1966."True democracy or the swaraj of the masses can




